HAPPY NEW YEAR! I wish each of you a blessed New Year & one that brings you, health, happiness and joy and recovery from the Pandemic!

COYOTES: Additional information may be found on the bulletin board in the Club House.

I have been in touch with several agencies regarding the coyotes spotted in our community. They have told me that coyotes are curious and timid animals and generally run away if challenged. However, they will protect itself or its young. Do NOT leave food out for stray animals (cats, birds, squirrels, etc.). Doing so eliminates the natural fear they have towards humans. This encourages the coyotes to stay in our area. Keep your pet on a short lease when walking. If a coyote approaches too closely, act aggressively towards the coyote. Yell, throw a rock or stick at it, blow a whistle or air horn, wave your arms wildly. This can convince the coyote you are a danger to it. Make sure to close off any crawl space under your home. See the bulletin board for additional info.

LOT RENTS: The new amounts go into effect January 1st, 2021. A letter was sent in September 2020 informing you of the amounts. The following choices are still in effect for making your payments: If you have any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to contact me.

* ACH (also known as direct debit) – Most have signed up for this option which is the most

effective way. For this option, you do not need to do anything. The amount comes out on the 3rd of the month automatically. If you wish to switch to this method, please let me know.

* COUPON BOOK - The new books have been sent and you should have by Thursday, 12/31/20. They were sent to the address we had on record. The new coupon book has all the updated info in it including labels to the where they are to be mailed which is Center State Bank, PO Box 20846, Tampa, Florida. Labels are in the back of the book.

* ONLINE BANKING- If you currently use online banking whereby you enter the information yourself, you will need to update the amount on your bank website or you will not pay the correct amount.

* ONLINE PAYMENT PORTAL- The Resident Portal is at: www.newbymanagement.com. You can pay by e-check as well as by credit card. Should you choose to use your credit card, you will be charged the 3-5% processing fee that the credit card companies charge. You can also see your account with your charges and payments.

Some have indicated that their banks take the money out directly. This means that you have set it up directly with your bank to be taken out and you would need to contact your bank and update your NEW information with them.
